A BRIEF ABOUT ENVIRONMENTAL AND SOCIAL MONITORING REPORT

The Environmental and Social Monitoring Report (ESMR) provides periodic updates of the Van Phong 1 Power Plant Project with regards to environmental and social management in accordance with international standards. Below are the updates for the period from October 2020 to March 2021.

PROJECT STATUS UPDATE

The construction has been conducted for many civil activities, such as site leveling and shore protection, piling, excavation, and concrete works. Besides, the offshore work is also continuing for dredging, piling, concrete casting in trestle.



OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY

The Project has achieved 3 million manhour without LTI in March 2021. This achievement is to confirm the hard-working effort to maintain and improve the environment and safety measure on site.

The Covid-19 pandemic continuous occurring in Vietnam and other countries. As part of social effort of Covid-19 prevention, the countermeasures are still strictly implemented and we comply with the WHO or MOH guidance to minimize the community transmission impact on the project area.

ENVIRONMENTAL MONITORING

Air quality

All TSP, CO, NO₂, SO₂, PM₁₀ results showed that all parameters were complying with relevant regulations.

Noise and vibration

The noise and vibration level were mostly in accordance with Vietnamese regulations and IFC guidelines during the period of construction activities.

Wastewater

Wastewater in site office and worker accommodations are regularly tested. Most parameters are in the allowable limit of Vietnamese regulation. Based on the test result, if any parameter would slightly exceed, the root cause of this exceedance will be analyzed and figured out. The quality of the wastewater was confirmed to be consistent with the requirement before discharging.

Soil

As last semiannual results, soil sampling was still maintained at 03 locations. Monitoring data were in the allowable range of Vietnamese standards.

Groundwater

The groundwater sampling results showed that most parameters in 03 locations were in line with relevant regulations.

Seawater

The seawater was taken at 02 locations and most parameters were not exceeded the standards of Vietnam regulation on seawater quality.


LIVELIHOOD RESTORATION PROGRAM

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM




VPCL supported to establish Van Phong Junior Football Club with Ninh Phuoc commune. Around 80 boys and girls joined the club and enjoy practicing football
